Interview

At Canadian National Miss interview is one of our most important competitions. We want our queens to have a strong platform or cause that they want to work on for their year of reign. In this portion of the competition you will have the opportunity to explain this to the judges. There will be ZERO political questions. The questions will all be about you and why you should be the next queen. Our interviews are held in a round-robin format. You will rotate through one on one interviews with each judge. Attire for this competition is more glamourous than your average job interview so feel free to incorporate your own style into the look. We suggest wearing a dress or jumpsuit style outfit.



Evening Gown

25%

Evening gown is the most glamourous and elegant phase of competition for the delegates. We ask that all evening gowns worn in this competition are floor length gowns. While slits, mesh panels and low necklines are allowed at Canadian National Miss, please consider if the style is appropriate as this will factor into scoring.



Fun Fashion

25%

Fun Fashion is you chance to show your personality on stage. Choose something that will pop and show the judges who you are! Your outfit can be anything you choose as long as it is not a floor length gown. On stage contestants will be asked to do a minimum of two turns in their routine (these can be full of half turns) to demonstrate your modeling skills.



Personal Introduction

At Canadian National Miss we admire the skill of public speaking. Each contestant will have 45 seconds to deliver a speech about themselves. This should include their name, age, hobbies or interests as well as their chosen platform or cause they support as a Canadian National Miss contestant. The key to this competition is having compelling content and delivering it in a professional and engaging manner. The speech will be presented on stage directly following the opening number. You will wear the same black dress as your opening number outfit for the Introduction competition.






OPTIONAL COMPETITIONS

Miss Congeniality

1 Winner Per Division

Awarded to the most helpful, friendly and kind delegate in each division. This award is voted by contestants in each division.

Miss Photogenic

1 Winner Per Division

Awarded to the delegate with the best photo as voted by the judges. This is a sperate award and is not included in overall scoring.

Miss Interview

1 Winner Per Division

Awarded to the woman with the highest interview score for her age division.

Miss Introduction

1 Winner Per Division

Awarded to the woman with the highest introduction score for her age division.

Miss Evening Gown

1 Winner Per Division

Awarded to the woman with the highest evening gown score for her age division.

Miss Fun Fashion

1 Winner Per Division

Awarded to the woman with the highest fun fashion score for her age division.


Opening Number/Introduction Outfit

For this competition delegates will get to wear a dress of their choice that will be worn for both the opening number as well as the scored Introduction competition. This outfit can be a

dress, or a jumpsuit. The only requirements for this outfit is that is must be ALL BLACK (no beading or sequins in other colours) and it must not be a floor length gown.







Code of Conduct

City Titleholders

- Inappropriate posts in relation to the Canadian National Miss pageant will not be tolerated. This includes social media posts with crude language and explicit photos. You are free to post what you like on your own personal social pages as long as there is no association to the pageant (ex. wearing official city sash, tagging Canadian National Miss, or mentioning the pageant in the caption).
- Photos with the official sash cannot be combined with another crown or worn with another sash from a different pageant system.
- Contestant must be professional and show good sportsmanship to all fellow delegates and staff at all times. Claims with proof of harassment or bullying will lead to probation or disqualification from the competition.
- Canadian National Miss City Titleholders do not have a non-compete clause. Contestants are allowed to compete in other pageant systems while being a delegate with Canadian National Miss.
- Canadian National Miss has the right to refuse any contestant from entering if they do not reflect the values of Canadian National Miss.
- Breaking rules set out by staff before and during the national competition will result in point deductions on a contestant's overall score.
- Each contestant is responsible for the behaviour of all supporters, including friends, family, hair/makeup artists, designers etc.

 If anyone associated with a contestant violates the official pageant rules, this will also result in deductions in contestant's score.

National Queen Titleholders

- Inappropriate posts in relation to the Canadian National Miss pageant will not be tolerated. This includes social media posts with crude language and explicit photos. You are free to post what you like on your own personal social pages as long as there is no association to the pageant (ex. wearing official national sash and crown, tagging Canadian National Miss, or mentioning the pageant in the caption).
- Photos with the official sash cannot be combined with another crown or worn with another sash from a different pageant system.
- National Queens must be professional and show good sportsmanship to all future delegates during their reign. Claims with proof of harassment or bullying are grounds to remove the current titleholder and present the first runner-up with the title and prize package.
- The removal of a queen would require her to relinquish her title and to return all the prizes won.
- Canadian National Miss National Queens do not have non-compete clause.
- All queens are required to attend the royalty cruise and return to the national pageant the following year to crown her successor. Failure to attend all events is grounds for removal.
- Each National Queen is required to post a minimum of 40 posts related to Canadian National Miss (this includes main posts and stories on Facebook and Instagram) throughout her year long reign on her titleholder account.
